- Q.5 "Agreement which ceases to be enforceable by law becomes void when it ceases to be enforceable" Discuss with reference to the provisions relating to subsequent impossibilities of performance of contract.
- Q.6 "An agreement without consideration is void." What are the exceptions to this general rule provided in Contract Act 1872?

- Q.7 Define condition and warranty. What are implied conditions provided in sale of goods Act 1990?
- Q.8 What are the rights of Unpaid Seller under Sale of Goods Act?

Part D WEST PAKISTAN CIVIL COURT ORDINANCE

- Q.9 Briefly explain the pecuniary and local jurisdiction of courts.
- Q.10 Discuss the law to file appeals against the orders of Civil Judges, Additional District Judges, and District Judges provided in Civil Courts Ordinance 1962.
