

**NOTIFICATION**

**Notification No.** KPSC/ B&A-52 / 2017/ Vol-I/ 117/74-85 . In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 10 (A) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission (Amendment) Ordinance, 2002 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Ordinance No. XXVII of 2002), the Commission is pleased to direct that in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission Regulations, 2017, the following further amendments shall be made, namely: -

**AMENDMENT**

- i) Clause (d) of Regulation 24 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission Regulations 2017 shall be substituted as under: -

“The marks obtained in screening / ability test shall have weightage and shall be counted for shortlisting purpose.”

- ii) Clause (a) of Regulation 28 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission Regulations 2017 may be substituted as under: -

“Marking in the case of posts filled other than through a prescribed syllabus based examination shall be made by scoring out of 100 marks to be distributed between the academic achievements of the candidates, **screening test** and interview as given below: -

i)	Academic Record	20
ii)	Distinction for standing first in Board/ University	04
iii)	Hifz-ul-Quran	03
iv)	Higher Relevant Qualification	03
v)	Screening Test	45
vi)	Interview	25

- iii) Clause (c) of Regulation 28 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission Regulations 2017 shall be substituted as under: -

“Academic scoring in respect of professional and non- professional posts shall be based on the last four or five examinations i.e., Matric, Intermediate, Bachelor and Master or Professional examination as the case may be, on the basis of percentage to 20 marks reserved for academic record and not on division wise basis. *For example*, if a candidate obtains 2150 marks out of 2500 marks his credit will come to 17.20 marks out of 20. So in such cases, the candidate shall be entitled to 17 marks”.

- iv) After Clause (k) of Regulation 28, another clause (l) shall be inserted as under: -

“There will be negative marking in screening/ ability test. Each answer shall carry two marks and for each wrong answer, one mark shall be deducted”.

v) After Clause (l) of Regulation 28, another clause (m) shall be inserted as under: -

"Where screening/ ability test is not held under Regulation 12(a), selection shall be made out of 55 marks without adding the 45 marks reserved for screening test".

vi) After Clause (m) of Regulation 28, another clause (n) may be inserted as under: -

"Percentage formula of conventional system and semester system shall be as under: -

Conventional = Obtained Marks x 100 / Total Marks  
Semester = Obtained CGPA x 100 / Total CGPA = Resultant x 0.9

vii) The amendments / insertions shall not be made applicable in cases where screening / ability tests or interviews are already scheduled or have held under the existing procedure.


