The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission fully adheres to its rules and regulations and carries the trust of government and public by providing quality human resource through a merit-based, transparent and unbiased recruitment to the Provincial Government departments. Merit is the core value and is being enthusiastically pursued by the Commission.

During the Quarter, the Commission recommended 338 candidates as Assistant Sub-Inspectors in Police Department while 265 candidates as lecturers in various subjects in Higher Education Department. Moreover, eight parallel interview panels wherein seven for the post of lecturers in various subjects and one for the post of Tehsildar/Naib Tehsildar scheduled so as to ensure early induction of lecturers pending for interview.

## TESTS AND EXAMINATIONS HELD DURING 2<sup>ND</sup> QUARTER, 2022

### ABILITY TESTS

The Commission conducted 79 Ability Tests for 56875 candidates against 781 posts in various departments in four phases in Peshawar as the number of candidates was manageable. Department-wise detail is as follow:

### PHYSICAL TESTS

The Commission conducted physical test for the posts of Male Assistant Superintendent Jail in Home & Tribal Affairs Department for 7185 candidates against 24 posts from 16<sup>th</sup> May to 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2022. Total 2646 candidates appeared in the test where 1934 were declared physically fit for the post. Physical Test for the posts of Sub Inspector in Directorate of Tourism was also held for 769 candidates from 13<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> June, 2022. Only 147 candidates declared fit out of 178.

### COMPETITIVE EXAM FOR THE POST OF DEPUTY SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE

The Commission conducted competitive exam for the 07 posts of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Fast Track Promotion) in Police Department from 15 to 23 June, 2022. After scrutiny of 212 applications, 46 applicants were found eligible for written exam, however, the court allowed 6 more candidates on interim relief making the total number of eligible candidates as 52 wherein 43 candidates appeared in the written exam.

## RECOMMENDATIONS CONVEYED DURING 2<sup>ND</sup> QUARTER, 2022

Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission recommended 627 candidates to the government for appointment against various posts in different departments after interviewing 2084 candidates. The recommendees include 338 candidates for the posts of Assistant Sub-Inspector in Police Department and 265 for the posts of lecturers in various subjects in Higher Education Department. Total 96 posts remained leftover in which 82 pertained to Police Department. Recommendations of 36 selectees have been kept pending due to Court Cases and other technical reasons. Moreover, 46 posts (34 for female quota & 12 for minority quota) remained unfilled due to non-availability of eligible/ suitable candidates and will be re-advertised in due course of time.
