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REVISION OF ZONAL ALLOCATION FORMULA

The Provincial Government has revised the Zonal Allocation Formula on 22nd December, 2022 by dividing the Province into 6 zones on the basis of population for the purpose of initial recruitment. A block of 30 vacancies has been devised for posts in BPS-16 and 17 as well as Civil Judge/Judicial Magistrate (BPS-18) out of which 6 vacancies have been reserved for merit, 04 for Zone-I comprising Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Orakzai, Kurram, N.Waziristan, S.Waziristan and Tribal Sub-Divisions, 06 for Zone-II consisting of districts of Peshawar, Nowshera, Mardan, Charsadda and Sawabi, 04 for Zone-III comprising Malakand, Swat, Dir Lower and Upper, Chitral, 04 for Zone-IV comprising districts of Kohat, Hangu, Karak, Bannu, Lakki Marwat and DI Khan, 03 for Zone-V comprising districts of Abbottabad, Mansehra and Haripur and 03 for Zone-VI comprising Battagram, Kohistan Lower and Kohistan Upper, Kolai Pallas Kohistan, Torghar, Shangla, Buner, Tank, Gadoon and Backward areas of Haripur and Mansehra.

In pursuance of the revised Zonal Allocation Formula, the KP PSC, in consultation with the Establishment Department, notified the Zonal Rotational Cycle on 31st January, 2023 and all departments were asked to send requisitions as per the notified new Zonal Allocation Formula and Zonal Rotational Cycle.

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RECOMMENDATIONS ISSUED DURING THE 1st QUARTER

The Commission finalized recruitment against the following **398** posts in various departments. Out of **31159** applicants, **2045** candidates were interviewed and recommendations of **338** candidates were sent to the department concerned while **60** posts remained unfilled. RECOMMENDATIONS OF INSPECTOR

The Commission recommended 14 Inspectors (BPS-16) against 50 posts to the government for appointment in the Police Department. Two posts were kept pending due to final decision of court while 34 posts remained unfilled due to non availability of eligible candidates.

The Commission advertised 50 posts of Inspector (BPS-16) and 65 Posts of Sub Inspector (BPS-14) under fast track promotion quota in Police Department. Written exam was conducted from 1st August, 2022 to 11th August, 2022 where 44 out of 379 candidates appeared for the post of Inspector and 6 out of 306 for Sub Inspector. Result of the written part was announced on 17th November, 2022 wherein 16 Candidates declared qualified for interview conducted on 1st and 2nd February, 2023 for the post of Inspector. Unfortunately, no one qualified the written exam for the post of Sub Inspector hence 65 posts remained leftover.

RECOMMENDATIONS OF PROVINCIAL PLANNING SERVICE (PPS)

The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission recommended **44** candidates; to the government for appointment for the post of Provincial Planning Service (PPS) while one post in the share of Minority Quota remained unfilled due to non availability of eligible candidate. Total candidates were **10713** wherein **2781** appeared in the written exam. Result of written part was announced on 13.09.2022 where **368** (13%) candidates qualified for viva voce.

Written exam was consisted of 5 subjects i.e. English (Precise and Compositions), English Essay, General Knowledge, Islamiat and Economics. In the exam the subject of General Knowledge proved easy where 97% candidates qualified followed by Islamiat with 91% passing ratio. The subject of English Essay proved tough with 27% candidates passing ratio. Subject-wise passed/ failed ratio may be seen in the given table:-

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENT

In the Quarter under report, the IT Wing of the Commission is equipped with two new heavy duty printers and two OMR Scanners under the scheme "Upgradation of IT System". The printers perform multi functions i.e. Copying, Printing, Scanning, Faxing and Stapling. The updated and modern printer having speed of 105 pages per minutes (PPM), prints 6300 copies per hour and having paper capacity 570 sheets.

Optical Marks Reader (OMR) Scanner machine having speed of 90 pages per minutes, volume 5400 copies per hour and having capacity of 300 sheets are placed at the disposal of secrecy section for scanning and marking the question papers having multiple choice questions (MCQs). With completion of the above project, the working capacity of the Commission will be enhanced manifold.

POSTS ADVERTISED

The Commission advertised 3 posts of Tehsildar one each for Merit, Zone-1 and Zone-2 in Board of Revenue and Estate Department for which the last date of receipt of applications was 28th March, 2023. Total 1909 candidates applied; Male 1622 and Female 253 while Seven candidates belonging to Minority and twenty seven (27) from Disable Quota were there.
