Capt. (Retd) Sikander Qayyum, Chairman KP PSC called on the Honourable Acting Governor, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Mr. Mushtaq Ahmad Ghani on 2<sup>nd</sup> August, 2022. The Chairman KP PSC presented the Annual Report of KP PSC for the year 2021 and also apprised the Governor of the issues faced by KP PSC in carrying out its functions in particular; that of holding of screening test before competitive examinations, legal status of PSC and financial flexibility of KP PSC. The Hon'able Acting Governor assured the Chairman of his continued sponsorship and support to KP PSC in its functions and endeavour of selecting/ hiring the best of the best for the KP Govt.

## APPOINTMENT OF HONOURABLE MEMBER

Under Section 3 of KP PSC Ordinance 1978, Mr. Farman Ullah Anjum, Ex DG HRD of Higher Education Commission appointed as new Member of KP PSC took oath of his office on 18.07.2022. Capt. (Retd.) Sikander Qayyum Chairman PSC administered the oath. The Commission welcomed him expecting observance of highest degree of merit, transparency and professionalism from the new Member.



## MEETINGS OF THE COMMISSION

The meetings of the Commission are held on regular basis wherein issues of importance are discussed and decisions taken. During the year 2022, a total of seven meetings of the Commission were held. Important decisions were taken with regard to the Service Regulations for the posts of Director & Deputy Director Curriculum & Research, role of Members on Selection Boards of various universities, recruitments of Lecturers and amendment in PSC Regulations. In the current (3<sup>rd</sup>) quarterly review (July-September, 2022) The Commission held its meetings on 05.07.2022, 02.08.2022 and 07.09.2022.



## RECRUITMENT OF LECTURERS

Out of 1900 posts of lecturers requisitioned by Higher Education Department, the Commission finalized recommendations of 1200 candidates for appointment against the posts. The posts were advertised in Advertisement No.06/2021. Keeping in view the urgency, the Commission had to increase the number of panels of interviews as well as candidates per panel. Presence of an advisor/ subject specialist from university and a departmental representative of the Higher Education Department were ensured in each and every panel for better evaluation/ assessment of the candidates. Fifteen

candidates were interviewed per panel making a total of 150 candidates per day. The Commission believes that teachers and lecturers are nation builders and their induction should be made after due diligence and proper assessment. In addition to command on the subject, the power of demonstration and communication skills of the candidates for the posts of Lecturer are taken into consideration by the panels of interview. At least 30 minutes are required for assessing a candidate. The Commission strives its level best to make possible early finalization of the recommendations against the posts of lecturer without compromising merit and transparency.

The following recommendations were sent to Higher Education, Archives and Libraries Department during the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter, 2022:-

In addition to the above, the Commission finalized recommendations against 16 posts in other Departments during the quarter.

## RECRUITMENT OF TEHSILDAR/ NAIB TEHSILDAR

The Commission finalized the recruitment process against 17 advertised posts of Tehsildar and 41 posts of Naib Tehsildar in Revenue and Estate Department. 752 candidates qualified the written examination. 12 candidates per day were interviewed giving at least 30 minutes to each candidate for assessment. The interviews continued from 16<sup>th</sup> May, to 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2022. Out of 17 posts of Tehsildar, 07 female candidates were recommended wherein 05 female

candidates were recommended against zonal posts and 02 got female reserved seats. 05 female candidates were recommended as Niab Tehsildar. From minority quota 02 candidates were selected as Naib Tehsildars. The Selected candidates were given motivational talk by the panel on 08.09.2022.



#### RESULT OF THE WRITTEN EXAM: FOR THE POSTS OF DEPUTY SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE

The Commission announced the result of written examination for 07 posts of Deputy Superintendent of Police against Fast Track Promotion in Police Department on 16<sup>th</sup> August, 2022. Out of total of 43 candidates only 20 candidates qualified for viva voce. The interviews will tentatively be scheduled in November, 2022.

#### RESULT OF THE COMPETITIVE EXAM: FOR THE POSTS OF PROVINCIAL PLANNING SERVICE

The Commission announced the result of competitive examination for the posts of Provincial Planning Service (PPS) on 13.09.2022. The competitive exam was held from 22<sup>nd</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 where 2772 candidates appeared out of 10713. Only 369 candidates qualified for next phase i.e. viva voce, making passing ratio 13 percent. The interviews will tentatively be scheduled in November, 2022.

#### WRITTEN EXAM : FOR THE POSTS OF INSPECTOR IN POLICE DEPTT :

The Commission conducted written exam for 50 posts of Inspector (BPS-16) against Fast Track Promotion Quota with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2022. Only 36 candidates were found eligible while 339 candidates were declared ineligible; mostly due to lack of the required length of experience or had not been confirmed in the rank as per service rules of the Police Department. Out of 36 eligible candidates 35 appeared in the written examination. The exam consisted of 8 papers including special parts of major acts, local and special laws, police law and rules, case file preparation/crime scene, forensic & medical jurisprudence, Intelligence and surveillance, human rights, modern policing concept, English, general knowledge and computer literacy. Result will tentatively be announced in Nov: 2022.

#### WRITTEN EXAM : FOR THE POSTS OF SUB-INSPECTOR IN POLICE DEPTT:

The Commission conducted a written exam for 65 posts of Sub-Inspector (BPS-14) against Fast Track Promotion Quota with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> August to 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2022. Only 11 candidates were found eligible whereas 295 were declared ineligible mostly on account of the lack of required experience. Total of 05 candidates appeared for the written examination. Result will tentatively be announced in Nov: 2022.

#### ABILITY TESTS HELD DURING 3<sup>RD</sup> QUARTER-2022

The Commission conducted 30 ability tests for 66842 candidates for various posts in different departments. Detail is follows: -
