Online applications are invited for the following posts from Pakistani citizens having domicile of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa by **20-11-2024 (05:00 PM)** within country and abroad.

Candidates are advised to fill all columns carefully and preview their application forms for correction if any, before apply.

Candidates are required to submit attested copies of all documents, original experience certificate and other testimonials on the prescribed proforma within 15 days after closing date of submission of online applications. They should also upload scanned copies of their documents alongwith e-application, if not already submitted.

S.No.1 **ONE HUNDRED & TWELVE POSTS (38 FRESH AND 74 LEFT OVER POSTS) OF CIVIL JUDGES-CUM-JUDICIAL MAGISTRATES/ ALAQA QAZI IN PESHAWAR HIGH COURT PESHAWAR.**

Qualification:- Degree in law from a recognized University entitling him / her to practice the profession of law or is a Barrister of England or Ireland or is a Member of the Faculty of Advocates of Scotland and have practiced the profession of law in the High Court or in the Courts subordinate thereto, for a period not less than two (02) years after enrollment as an advocate.

The expression "practiced the profession of law" shall include any period of government service by a personal as Government Pleader, Public Prosecutor, Additional Government Pleader or Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of Government.

Age Limit: 23 to 32 years **Pay Scale:** BPS-18 **Eligibility:** Both Sexes

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- i) Application by an eligible candidate shall be submitted online on prescribed form given at the website of the Commission (i.e., www.kppsc.gov.pk) on or before the closing date of advertisement.
- ii) The candidates shall have to deposit prescribed application fee as per procedure given in the advertisement on or before the closing date of advertisement.
- iii) Candidates are required to make correct entries in the online application which can be documentarily proved as on the basis of their claim/ entries they will be called for Examination.
- iv) Age shall be reckoned on last date fixed for submission of applications online.
- v) Two years optimum relaxation in upper age limit shall be allowed to:
 - a) Government servants with a minimum of two years continues service;
 - b) Disable persons; and
 - c) Candidates from backward areas.
- vi) The period which a Barrister or an Advocate of the High Court and / or the Courts subordinate thereto or a Pleader has practiced in the Bar, shall be excluded for the purpose of upper age limit subject to a maximum period of two years from his / her age.
- vii) The required two years experience certificate must be duly countersigned by the Session Judge concerned.
- viii) Candidates are required to submit complete documents, experience certificate and other testimonials on the prescribed Performa within 15 days after closing date of submission of online applications.
- ix) Only the qualification possessed on the closing date of the advertisement shall be taken into consideration.
- x) Candidates are advised to submit only one application form online, it will be considered for all categories/quotas mentioned above.
- xi) Those candidates shall be called for disabled seats who are in possession of a certificate issued by the Board of Rehabilitation / District Assessment Board for disabled persons stating their disability on the basis of report of standing Medical Board.
- xii) All candidates appearing for competitive examination shall be allowed three chances for each individual examination while four chances shall be allowed in combination of competitive examinations for the post of Provincial Management Service, Civil Judges- cum -Judicial Magistrates and such other posts which the government may include in these categories of posts.
- xiii) Degrees / Experience Certificates / Testimonials of unrecognized institution are not accepted.
- xiv) Applicants married to Foreigners are considered only on production of the Govt: Relaxation Orders.
- xv) Employees of Govt: / Semi-government institutions/ autonomous/ semi-autonomous bodies may apply directly but their departmental permission certificates shall be required before competitive examination.
- xvi) The zonal and merit quotas shall be strictly followed in the allocation of seats. Government reserves the right to increase/decrease or fill or not to fill any post. No zonal reservation stands for posts allocated to minority/disable and female quotas. These shall be filled in on open merit.
- xvii) Where the candidate remains absent in the competitive examination his chance will remain intact. However, if he appears in any one subject he / she will be deemed to have availed the chance.
- xviii) Grace marks are not allowed.
- xix) The candidates shall attach/produce the domicile certificate which had been issued to them by the competent authority before the last date fixed for receipt of applications. No alteration in the entries with regard to domicile certificate shall be accepted subsequently. Domicile once produced shall be final. A candidate shall be entitled for having one domicile only otherwise he / she shall become ineligible.

- xx) A married female candidate not already in government service may either adopt the domicile of her husband or may retain her own domicile. However, option once exercised in online application form shall be final and change of domicile shall not be allowed thereafter.
- xxi) If any candidate is found ineligible at any stage under the rules for the examination, his/ her candidature will be cancelled regardless of the fact whether he/she has appeared in the examination or qualified therein. To avoid frustration the candidates are advised in their own interest to make sure before appearing in the examination that they fulfill all the requirements of the rules relating to the examination.
- xxii) Before interview, the Commission will hold Psychological/ aptitude test and no candidate will be called for interview if he/ she failed to appear in the Psychological/ aptitude test.
- xxiii) Call letters for test will be placed on KP PSC website. Candidates must keep visiting the PSC website from time to time.

- b) The candidates shall opt for Urdu or Pushto papers on prescribed form.
- a). There shall be a competitive examination for the posts. The prescribed syllabus is available on official website of the Commission i.e www.kppsc.gov.pk/syllabus .
